<p>School Blazer School sweater (optional) ‘Trutex’ Ribston blouse with revered collars (may be short or long sleeved) House badge* Ribston Hall High School Bottle Green pleated skirt or Black Trutex Trousers with the School Logo White socks or flesh / black coloured tights Black sensible shoes. (Boots, sandals, training shoes, canvas shoes and ‘dolly shoes’ are not suitable).</p>

Jewellery	<p>The only jewellery that may be worn is a wristwatch. For those with pierced ears, only one pair of studs may be worn. Nose studs or other piercings may not be worn. No other jewellery will be allowed.</p> <p>Hair accessories should be black, green or yellow.</p>
Coats	<p>A suitable school coat may be worn. Leather and Denim jackets are not suitable for school and must not be worn.</p>

Physical Education	<p>Black and green shirt Black and green skort White ankle socks for netball, tennis, rounders and athletics Green socks for hockey Black RHHS track bottoms Black RHHS fleece Training shoes are suitable for all aspects of PE. However, it is unwise to send your daughter to school with expensive training shoes. Initials may be printed on these items. (Training shoes should not be worn at other times)</p>
