

## A Level Music Tasks

Prepare a solo piece on an instrument of your choice. This will be recorded and marked during September in line with the A Level mark scheme.

1. **Listen** (at least 10 times!) to the following piece of music and prepare background notes on the composer, period, the work and give your musical opinions of the piece:

Then choose another work related to this set work e.g. a 1<sup>st</sup> Movement from a symphony by another composer, **listen** to it (at least 10 times) and prepare similar notes on it.

2. Research the word **CHORALE**.

Then answer the following questions:

- What is a Chorale?
- Which composer is most closely associated with the Chorale?
- How many did he write?
- Why did he write them?
- Briefly explain typical musical features in a Chorale
